

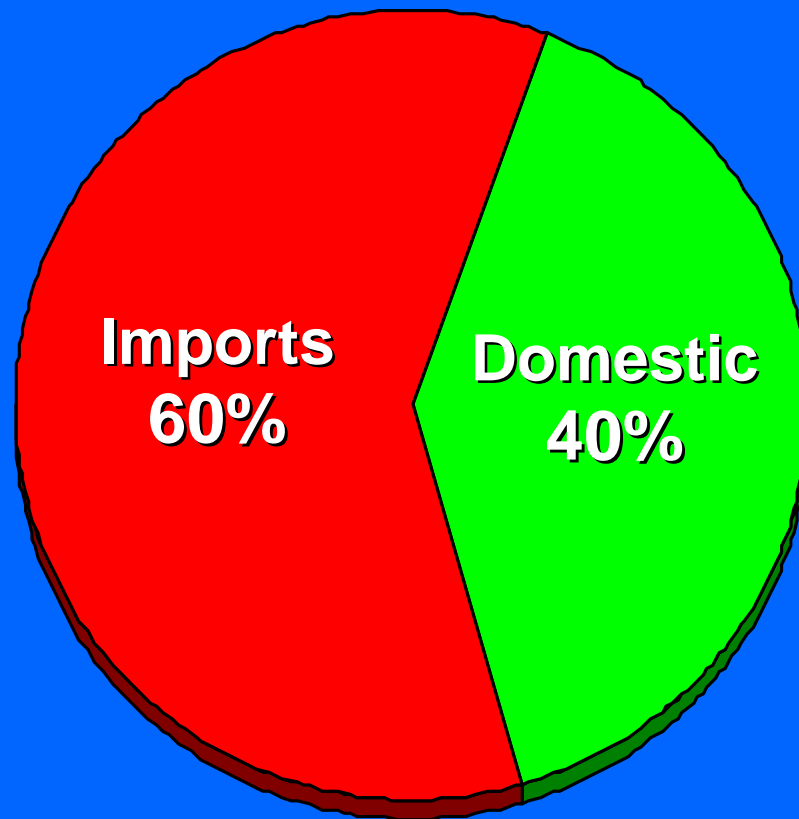

- **This represents over 1/3 of the total trade deficit**

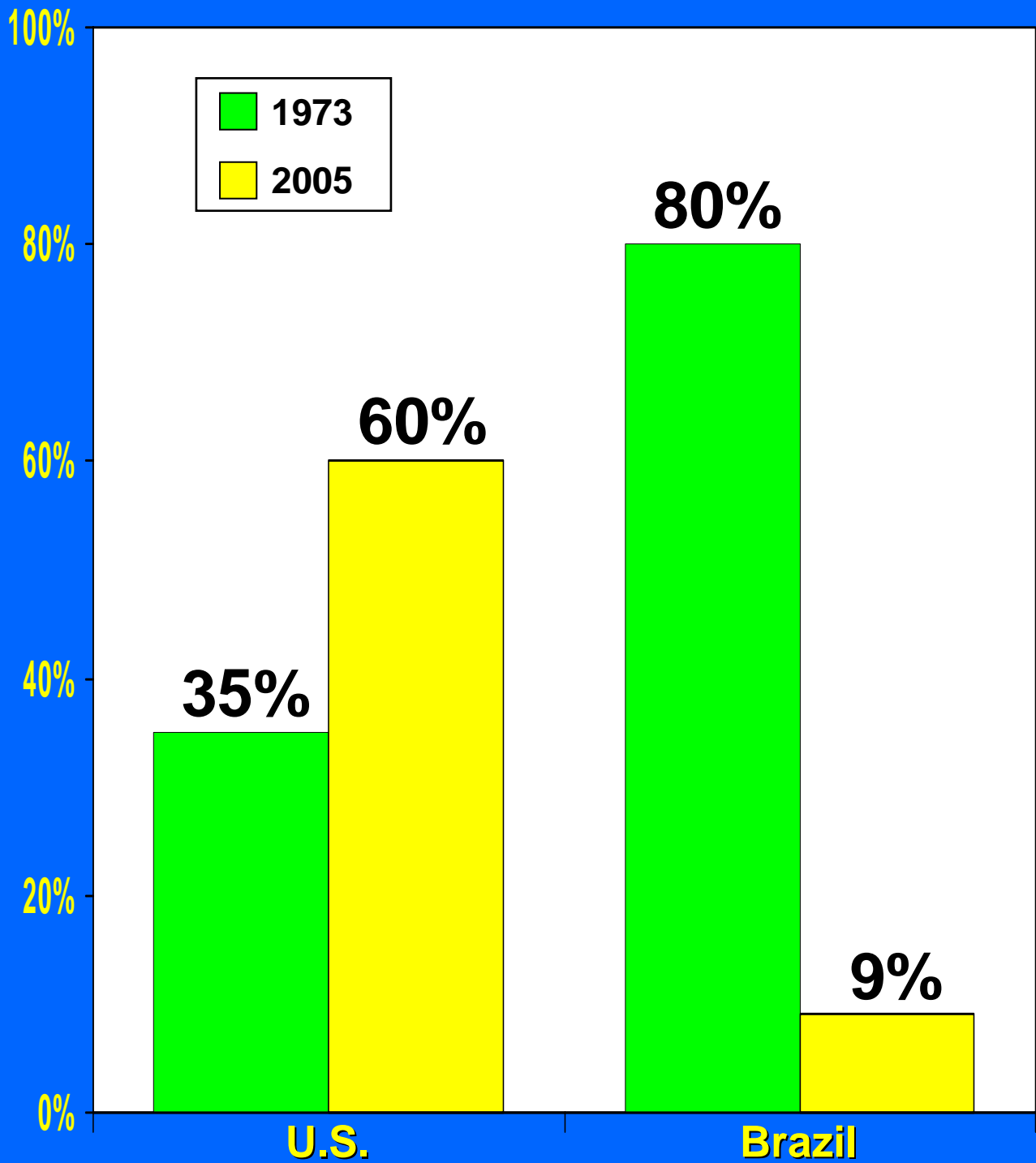
