Mr. ABRAHAM (for himself, Mr. GRAMS, Mr. NICKLES, Mr. FRIST,

and _____) proposed an amendment to the concurrent resolution setting forth the congressional budget for the United States Government for fiscal years 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, and 2005, revising the concurrent resolution on the budget for fiscal year 2000; as follows:

1 . *Strike Section 201 (b) (1) and insert the following:*

2 "1) IN GENERAL.-- It shall not be in order in the House of
3 Representatives or the Senate to consider ~~any~~ *any* revision to this concurrent
4 resolution, or any other concurrent resolution on the budget, or any
5 amendment thereto or conference report thereon, that sets forth a deficit for
6 any fiscal year."

7 *Insert at the end of Section 201 the following:*

8 "(e) WAIVER AND APPEAL. - Subsection (b) may be waived or suspended
9 in the Senate only by an affirmative vote of three-fifths of the Members, duly chosen
10 and sworn. An affirmative vote of three-fifths of the Members of the Senate, duly
11 chosen and sworn, shall be required in the Senate to sustain an appeal of the ruling
12 of the Chair on a point of order raised under this section."
