

**AMENDMENT TO THE CHAIRMAN'S MARK
For the Fiscal Year 2001 Senate Budget Resolution
Offered by Senator Boxer
To ensure that the President's after school initiative is fully
funded for FY 2001**

1. The Senate finds that –
 - (A) The demand for after school education is very high, with more than one million students waiting to get into such programs.
 - (B) After school programs improve educational achievement and have widespread support. Over 90 percent of the American people support such programs. Over 450 of the Nation's leading police chiefs, sheriffs, and prosecutors, along with the presidents of the Fraternal Order of Police, and the International Union of Police Associations support government funding of after school programs. And many of our Nation's governors endorse increasing the number of after school programs through a Federal/State partnership.
2. It is the sense of the Senate that the budget resolution assumes the President's level of funding for after school programs in fiscal year 2001, which will accommodate the current need.
